Anyhow, that's why I do Fanboy, to goof off and hang out. Satisfied, mom?

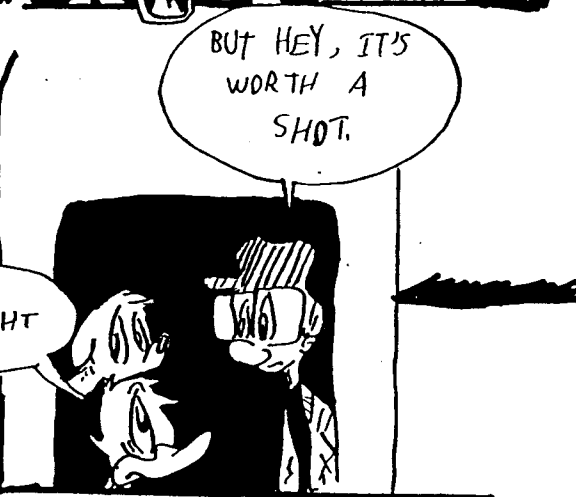
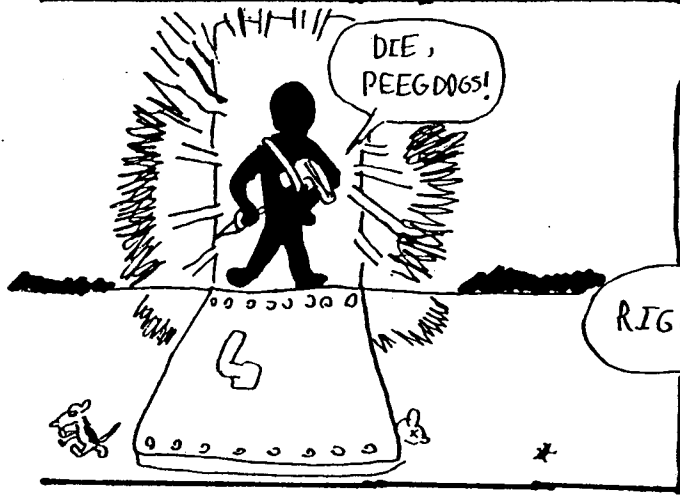
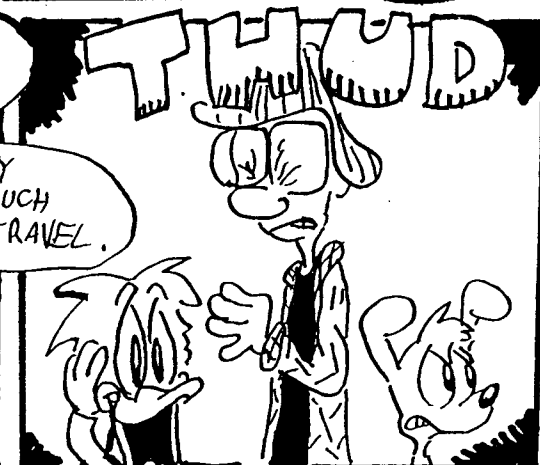
